GP appointments are available to book up to 3 months in advance. We also have emergency on the day appointments available each day. There may be days when GP's will triage your problem before offering you an appointment.

- Skin or Wound infections
- Urine infections

- B12

- Ear Syringing
- ECG
- Flu injections
- INR
- NHS health checks
- Over 75 health checks
- Smears
- Spirometry

When should I attend Accident & Emergency?

- Choking
- Severe breathing problems
- Severe chest pain
- Significant head injury
- Severe bleeding
- Loss of consciousness
- Seizure activity
- Severe allergic reaction
- Severe burns and scalds
- Stroke
- Major trauma
